

Y12 Duke of Edinburgh- Enrichment Information

- DofE SILVER award
- Open to those who have done Bronze before, or new entrants.
- Four areas. You must do 6, 6, 3 months if you've previously done the Bronze award, or 12, 6, 3 months if you haven't done Bronze (called 'Direct Entry').
 - VOLUNTEERING (6 or 12 months)
 - SKILLS (3, 6 or 12 months)
 - PHYSICAL RECREATION (3, 6 or 12 months)
 - EXPEDITION
- Approx ONE HOUR PER WEEK in each area over the number of months specified.
- VOLUNTEERING – give time to community, society or other people, the environment, animals..... Unpaid! Research required – training and goal setting.
- SKILLS – learn to drive, learn a language, musical instrument, learn to cook ... Can be a new skill or developing an existing one.
- PHYSICAL RECREATION – whatever you like! Can be an existing activity, or new one; regular participation, show improvement.
- EXPEDITION – training given on one or two **SATURDAYS** DURING THE YEAR.
- AFTER SCHOOL ON THURSDAYS (every 2 weeks) to monitor progress.
- PRACTICE EXPEDITION – 3 days, 2 nights, Spring/early summer, **WEEKEND**.
- FINAL EXPEDITION – 3 days, 2 nights, **Monday – Wednesday** of **last week of summer term**. Approx 25 miles.
- Regular attendance to **Thursdays 4pm Stone House Study Area** is required, and you must complete the other sections under your own initiative.
- Keep an eye on the INFORMATION SCREENS to make sure you don't miss any meetings.
- FIRST MEETING – DATE TO BE CONFIRMED 4.00pm in Stone House Study Area.
- COST - **£100** to cover TRAINING, STAFFING ON EXPEDITIONS, TRANSPORT, CAMPSITES.
- EQUIPMENT – we have a limited supply of tents, stoves and rucksacks. All other equipment you need to supply yourself.
