Types of course

Bachelor's Degrees – BSc (Hons) or BA (Hons) – 3 years if studying full time. Learn how to critique, analyse and develop research and investigative skills as well as transferable skills to take into a workplace. Usually, a dissertation is completed in the final year.

Foundation Degrees – FdSc or FdA – 2 years, tend to offer technically driven content and focus on employability skills through work-based learning modules

Bachelor's Degree Top-Ups – BSc (Hons) Top Up – can be taken after successful completion of Foundation Degrees to top up to a full honour's degree

Higher National Diploma – HND – 2 years and is a vocationally focused qualification equivalent to a Foundation Degree

Bachelor's Degrees with a Foundation Year – if you don't quite reach entry requirements for a full bachelor's degree this might be the right option to introduce you to higher level study


