- UCAS stands for University and Colleges Admissions Service
- It's an online service where all university applications and offers are managed in one centralised space
- After students have registered, they will be able to submit their applications and track progress

Student Journey




- The diagram shows the journey students will go on once they've sent off their application
- There are a couple of variations which students may find
- Not all courses will involve students having to attend an interview so they can just miss this step
- The second is that not all courses involve taking exams so again this step can be skipped

Getting Started

- Register for an account on UCAS
- Verify the account using the code provided
- Answer a series of questions around your studies
- Start the application process
- Link the account to your school, college or centre
- On the homepage is where you'll find progression of the application















Personal Details

 The students name should already be filled out but they will need to complete all the other mandatory fields



Contact Details

- You should provide either a landline or a mobile number
- You will only see the space to add nominated access details if you said yes to the question

guardian. If you are using an agent, you can choose to enter their details.






Employment

- If not, then you can still submit but must remember to mark the section as complete




Education

- With the education section, this is a multi-step process
- First you will be asked for your unique learner number, if this is not known then leave the question blank
- Next, you will add previous places of education then the current
- For each institution, all qualifications achieved will need to be added



Nationality

- UK nations will see a screen which looks like the top image
- Those who were born in the UK but have a different nationally will need to answers questions seen in the middle image
- Anyone applying from outside of the UK will see a different set of questions
- Depending on circumstances, visa and passport details may be required





Diversity & Inclusion

- With diversity, this won't hinder your application but will help application be treated fairly
- Any preparation activities you have taken part in such as summer schools can be noted here
- More information on your parents is required here such as previous education and their current occupation

- Any formatting such as bold or italics will be removed
- It is recommended that you type up your statement on a word document first rather than directly typing in the application form
