CAREERS GUIDANCE FOR STUDENTS

Careers Education is embedded into the year 12 tutor programme with students also engaging in career related activities throughout the year. These opportunities include assemblies, specific clubs such as the Biomed Club, and Business Breakfasts providing details on a range of career and study options.

At the end of year 12, students will also have the opportunity to attend a Beyond Sixth Form / Higher Education evening and also have time in July dedicated to considering the next steps beyond sixth form. In addition, there is a dedicated week for work experience at the start of July 2024 – further details about this will be provided in the next half term.
